

TESS' TOTS

Our PROGRAM FOR CHILDREN 6—24 MONTHS



"TESS' TOTS" refers to ELTHAM SWIMMING SCHOOL'S Parent and Child educational program.

With a commencement age of 6 months, this program forms the foundation for fast tracking a safer, independent and competent child in the water. Classes integrate special theme and activity days with deep water survival practices, ensuring that feel, respect and love for the water is developed.

Parents share in the joy of their child's development as they are guided by our specialist infant teacher.

At two years of age children are generally ready to move to a more formal program to develop skills independently. Parents have the option of choosing a class where they participate in the water, or one where they are not in the water.

- **We are continuing to offer our casual classes at the following times**

Tuesday & Wednesday at 10.10 am Saturday 8 am & 9:30 am

Cost \$12 per class

An exciting new option for us is our MAXIMUM SIZED GROUP CLASSES.

These classes are with a maximum of **6 children per class.**

We will hold these classes on Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday and Saturday mornings.

Times will be arranged according to demand.

ie; You tell us what you want, and we will do our best to accommodate it.

What does this class cost?

This class can only be done by **DIRECT DEBIT** \$32 per month for 11 months, commencing with the first deposit at your first class, and then on the 1st of each month until December.

(this may mean 2 debits in February)

This equates to a cost of \$8.60 per lesson. If you miss 2 out of every 7 lessons the cost will be no more than doing that number of casual lessons.

We do not offer make-up lessons or replacement lessons, as the critical thing is to keep a group together, of similar age and ability. That is why these classes are cheaper.
