SIMPLE STEPS TO ENROL (2021)

EXISTING CUSTOMERS

Your enrolment is ongoing, and does not pause with breaks (including at Xmas, January) Please make yourself familiar with our calendar

LESSON TIMES: Lesson times remain the same, however we highly recommend checking your Parent Portal immediately before attending

CHANGING TIMES: Please fill out a "CHANGE OF LESSON REQUEST" and email or return to reception

CEASING LESSONS: All cancellations **MUST** be done by email to <u>enquiries@elihamswim.com.au</u> This prevents any confusion.

Lesson cancellations must be in line with our cancellation policy attached to your ENROLMENT FORM, and/or CHANGE OF LESSON REQUEST

If changing lessons, we will do this as quickly as possible, and as close as possible to your request. We will advise by email, & Facebook when lesson times are available.

At Eltham Swimming School, Safety has always been our priority

Now there are extra Layers for us (and you)

Our Program

Is aimed at making your children as Water Safe as possible, whilst also making them excellent swimmers

Our Water

We have invested heavily in our water quality. These days, many facilities attempt to "disguise" how they treat their water. If you have heard of "SALT" or "MINERAL" water treatment, think "CHLORINE"

You cannot legally swim in commercial pool if it is not treated with Chlorine, and that is because it is not safe. Our Victorian Health regulations require Chlorine.

"Salt" & "Mineral" pools mean *chlorine is made on site* from the Salt etc.

If something goes wrong, you can be in a pool with no chlorine, and therefore be in an untreated pool.

However. We can minimise the level of chlorine and it's byproducts.

We do this by using Ultra Violet Light plus low chlorine. It is the best & the safest

How does this work?

Ultra Violet light has a bad reputation. <u>UV protection in sunscreen etc!!.</u> However, for sanitising water it excels. We keep it totally enclosed in a large stainless system (as pictured), where it works its magic. The pool water is completely sanitised each time it passes through our UV chamber, and then treated with Low chlorine. This is the best system available. It makes our pool the safest and healthiest water to swim in Check out the Hanovia system here:-

UV Water Disinfection for Aquatic Application

The other Alternative to UV (Ultra Violet Light) is Ozone treatment. Ozone treatment is as effective as UV.

So why don't we use Ozone?

Ozone is a gas added to the water as a purifier, but must be removed from the water prior to being returned to the pool.

We are not happy adding Gas to our water, so we have gone with UV, which is just a ray passing through the water in a secure Stainless steel Vessel. The only disadvantage is that UV uses quite a bit of electicity, but we have our 25 kw of Solar panels to help

SWIMMING ATTIRE

Swimming attire should be correct & appropriate, and not limit the ability of the children to swim easily. Children not toilet trained must wear an appropriate Swimmer Nappy or similar.

DANGEROUS ARTICLES

No breakable articles, such as glass or similar, are to be brought into the pool area. Please especially check drink containers

We have a "No Food Policy" within our centre, for hygiene reasons.



"Since we installed our Hanovia UV system a little over twelve months ago, we have experienced a 30% increase in registrations in our "5 and under class. Once word got around that our pool water quality was far superior to other pools, we have seen a steady stream of new parents enrolling their kiddies." Kevin Fitzpatrick, owner and proprietor of the Eltham Swim School in Eltham Victoria.





Prior to the introduction of the UV system, Kevin required weekly "super chlorination" and nightly "shock" chlorination just to keep pool chloramines at bay. Even after these measures, chloramine levels remained higher than Kevin wanted. Virtually as soon the Hanovia UV system was commissioned, chloramines levels dropped dramatically - well below the levels Kevin was able to achieve previously. "Super chlorination has become a matter of history for me since we installed the Hanovia UV system." Kevin has also reduced the free chlorine level in the pool because chloramines are now controlled by the UV system rather than elevated levels of free chlorine.

From a business perspective, the UV system has provided Kevin with significant opportunities. "Prior to the UV, I would close the centre for 48 hours a week to conduct super chlorination. Now I have the opportunity to open 7 days a week if I wished to." The UV and the associated chemical control system installed by Fluidquip Australia also significantly reduce his OH&S risk. This is because Kevin and his staff no longer need to manually handle pool chemicals. "Not only is our pool water now of excellent quality, it no longer requires manual intervention (in the form of chemical addition) to keep it that way." Having been in the swim school business for 29 years, Kevin is also very complementary about his relationship with Fluidquip Australia. "Fluidquip are fantastic" says Kevin. "I have been in the swim school game for a long time and I know when suppliers are being less than honest. One of the things I really like about Fluidquip is they are not like that at all - they are very honest and genuine to deal with." Kevin goes on to say "right from the start Fluidquip presented very well as a company. I was very confident they could offer me the personalized service I was looking for. How are fees charged?

We calculate your fees across the 22 weeks of lessons from the 17th January to the 29th June
All days have the same number of lessons

Fees

(fees are debited on the 1st day of the month except your January payment which is deducted on the 9th January)

1 or 2 children @ \$22.85 per child per lesson

MONTHLY DIRECT DEBIT

Eltham Swimming School Lesson Make Up Information

We offer a very generous Make up lesson system. It is critical you advise us if absent, as classes are usually very full, and we need to know as early as possible so that your missed lesson is available to others.

We only have a few criteria that MUST be met to qualify for MAKE UPS.

You must notify us of your absence a minimum of

2 hours

PRIOR TO ATTENDING THE SWIMMING SCHOOL.

Our only exception is if your class is before 10 am or between 3.30 - 5 pm weekdays

Make up Lessons can only be done whilst enrolled in the swimming school. We treat Make-up lessons like regular lessons. If you book a Make-up lesson, and fail to attend, it is the same as not advising us of non-attendance to your regular lesson and it is forfeited.

Do I need to complete Make-ups by any cutoff time?? No! Makeups can be done at any time as long as you are still enrolled for lessons at ESS.

By ensuring all absences are notified by our cutoff times you will be able to organise your replacement lessons more easily.

Our new class management program only records absences that you have notified us of. Failure to notify the swim school will mean you are not credited with a lesson

Our Program also includes the Life Saving Victoria "Swim & Survive" program. This program adds to our Level program with many other water safety skills, including their Clothed Swimming tests.



2020/21 Calendar







With a commencement age of 4 months, this program forms the foundation for fast tracking a safer, independent and competent child in the water. Classes ensure that feel, respect and love for the water is developed.

Parents share in the joy of their child's development as they are guided by our specialist infant teachers

At two years of age children are generally ready to move to a more formal program to develop skills independently without Mum or Dad in with them.

Classes are with a maximum of 5 children per class. We hold these lessons on each morning, 7 days per week

Payment is done via a monthly direct debit, calculated at a lesson rate of \$22.85 and averaged evenly each month.

What if my child is older than 24 months?

Your child will swim in our 2 years+ program. These are a maximum of 4 students per class.





MEMBERSHIP TERMS AND CONDITIONS



ENROLMENTS - LESSONS & SQUADS A signed enrolment form is to be completed, and submitted, with acknowledgement of terms and conditions. All new enrolments are completed by either submitting an Enrolment form, and completed Ezidebit Direct Debit form, in person, or by emailing a scanned copy to enquiries@elthamswim.com.au. Places are only secured once a completed direct debit form (EziDebit) and Enrolment form has been received, within 7 days of enrolment, or at your first lesson, whichever is the earlier. We do not hold places beyond these times.

CURRENTLY ENROLLED CLIENTS Continuing enrolment is deemed to be acceptance of these terms & conditions

ENROLMENTS ARE ONGOING Eitham Swimming School bookings are an ongoing booking, and once enrolled your booking will continue until an emailed withdrawal notification is received, subject to our cancellation policies (detailed below). Enrolments are on a term basis, however we charge fees by averaged monthly Direct Debit. Re-enrolments from Term to Term, and from Year to Year are not necessary once you are enrolled. This is an automatic re-enrolment.

NON TRANSFERABLE Memberships and lessons are non-transferable to other people and cannot be converted to other products or services

REQUEST FOR LESSON CHANGES While every effort is made to accommodate requests for change, it is dependent on the availability of vacancies and no guarantee can be given to accommodate exact requests. At year end, a LESSON CHANGE REQUEST FORM is required to be submitted in person or by email to enquiries@elthamswim.com.au if you wish to change your lesson time. If wishing to retain your current lesson booking, you do not need to do anything, as this is an

FEES & PAYMENT METHODS Lesson & Squad fees are paid by monthly Direct Debit (using Ezidebit), however bookings are for Terms listed below

BOOKING LENGTH Bookings are for a MINIMUM of a full term (4 Terms per calendar year). Cancellations are only available at the end of each term, which conclude on the following dates. Students with Medical Certificates are excluded from these booking dates. Cancellation of upcoming terms is required two (2) weeks prior to the commencement of the upcoming term. Our terms have set conclusion dates.

ANNUAL CALENDAR An annual calendar is produced, and on display at the swimming school. Dates are posted on our website (www.eithamswim.com.au). It is the client's responsibility to make themselves familiar with dates

MISSED LESSONS Compensation for missed lessons or make up lessons is not available (other than as Make – up Lessons) as a child's spot in a class is reserved solely for her / him during the term regardless of attendance.

MAKE-UP LESSONS Students who are unable to attend lessons can organise unlimited make-up lessons. Make up lessons can only be provided if spaces are available. Clients are expected to accept lessons offered. Make-up lessons expire only when a swimmer discontinues their enrolment. We endeavour to cater to the needs of make ups, but as there can be no guarantee of spots becoming available for everyone, we strongly advise all students to attend all their allocated classes as losses will be borne solely by the absentee

NOTIFICATION DEADLINES

Afternoon classes: Classes up to 5pm notification must be received by 3:30pm, classes from 5 pm onwards, notification must be received by 4 pm

FEES (& DIRECT DEBIT) You agree to have funds available in your nominated account on our scheduled debit date. If the bank rejects a transaction, your Direct Debit will be reset 3 days later. If your lesson occurs before the reset date, a payment must be made to reception prior to attending your lesson. Falled payments remain due and payable as per your contract. Ezidebit and your financial institute will charge a fee for failed debits. Any costs incurred by Eltham Swimming School in the processing of your fees will be passed on to you. Eltham Swimming School will charge a \$25.00 administration fee to each failed debit once 3 or more Direct Debit payments fail within a Calendar Year.

DISCOUNTS A discount is applied on fees if 3 or more siblings attend lessons. This does not apply to squads of 1 hour or more in duration.

TEACHERS AND TIME CHANGES We endeavour to provide you with consistency for your booking. In unusual situations, it may be necessary to cancel, or change classes or alter instructors. We will strive to maintain consistency, however this is not always possible.

CANCEL LATIONS

This contract of membership can be voided if written notification is provided.

- *2 weeks prior to the end of each term (Good Friday, 30th June, 30th September & 20th December) for the subsequent term.
- *By the 20th December each year, for the following year. •Immediately on presentation of a Medical Certificate. Lesson bookings are not reserved.
- New Students who have enrolled for the first time, can cancel at anytime in the first 4 weeks of their enrolment. Debits will be adjusted to reflect lessons
- *All terms and conditions of membership are binding once the Eltham Swimming School term commences.
